



Scholarship Announcement

Palestine Monetary Authority's Grant – Harvard Kennedy School

The Palestine Monetary Authority signed an agreement with Harvard University, under which it will allocate a fund for granting scholarships to Palestinian students who wish to obtain a Master's Degree in Public Administration – International Development. Under the agreement, Harvard University will contribute 50% of the Palestine Monetary Authority's contribution.

The Master's program in Public Administration in International Development, Harvard Kennedy School's newest program, is designed to prepare the next generation of leaders in international development. It is an economics-centered, multi-disciplinary program, combining rigorous training in analytical and quantitative methods with an emphasis on policy and practice.

Admission Requirements:

1. The applicant should be Palestinian, and must have received an offer of admission to the program.
2. A Bachelor's Degree in a related field.
3. Strong academic record, with satisfactory undergraduate scholastic average, a minimum of "Very Good".
4. Required prerequisite courses, including at least one university-level course each in microeconomics and macroeconomics, and three university-level courses in calculus, which must include multivariate calculus.
5. Demonstrated commitment to the field of international development and compelling evidence of professional potential in the field. While work experience is not an absolute requirement, development work often serves to demonstrate this commitment.
6. Strong recommendations from academic and professional references who know you well and can comment on the qualities needed for this program.
7. Competitive GRE or GMAT quantitative section score. In general, candidates who score in the top 80th percentile and above on the GRE or GMAT quantitative section are most competitive for admission.
8. Evidence of fluency in English as demonstrated by a minimum TOEFL score. The admission process at Harvard Kennedy School is through online application.
9. The applicant shall pledge to work at the Palestine Monetary Authority immediately upon completion of study for a period not less than three years.
